



There's So Much Mo in St. Jo!

Join us for this “MOJO Getaway” as we travel to historic St. Joseph, MO. This tour offers very unique and interactive museums. Our first stop is at the St. Joseph Museum Complex. At the beginning of this tour there will be an introduction at the Glore Psychiatric Museum, once known as the “State Lunatic Asylum No. 2.” Find out if you are a left brain or a right brain! This museum is recognized as “one of the 50 most unusual Museums in the country!” The collections are the largest and best single exhibition explaining the evolution of mental health care in the U.S. You will have free time to explore the rest of the museum complex on your own. See the extensive Native American collection and exhibits on the Lewis & Clark Expedition with emphasis on the journey through Northwest Missouri. See the latest exhibit, “Civil War Medicine.” You’ve heard about the battles, but do you know how soldiers were medically treated from the North to the South? You may also visit the Black Archives Museum which exhibits the Underground Railroad, the Middle Passage, Desegregation, the music scene and other aspects of African-American history in St. Joe. You can pick and choose what you want to see. Our next stop is at the Pony Express Museum. We’ll view a short movie while dining on a wonderful hot brisket lunch. This museum has added 5 new exhibits and was revamped for the 150th anniversary! You will be amazed at what you see and learn in this museum. The local guide takes us through and tells stories, making them come alive! St. Joe is known for the start of the Pony Express and the end of Jesse James, and our last stop, the Patee House Museum, played a role in both. This home is St. Joe’s ONLY National Historic Landmark, featuring two full floors of exhibits. It is a block size museum with so many exhibits! Next to this complex, we will visit the Jesse James Home Museum and see where Jesse James was shot and killed. The museum features artifacts from Jesse’s life and death, as well as others associated with him. You’ll see evidence from the 1995 exhumation, which proved with 99.7% certainty that the person killed in this house was, in fact, Jesse James!
